Our guild is proud to support the youth of our community in their interest in the field of fabric arts. In the past, we offered a \$500 scholarship award to a deserving student, in Brant County, who was going to further her/his education at the post-secondary level in the study of fashion, fabric arts or fibre arts.

Because there has been a very poor response to this scholarship application, we have restructured this award program.
